- The ability and willingness to teach more than one subject and active participation in our CAS program;
- Willingness to engage students beyond the classroom;
- Adventurous, challenge-seeking spirit;
- International mindedness – international experience is considered an asset;
- Experience in a UWC or IB school is considered an asset.

All applicants should have as much passion for teaching the subject to

highly motivated 16-19-year-old students. In addition, faculty and students at UWC Robert Bosch College see education extending far beyond the classroom. All teachers are expected to lead by example and partner with students in their engagement with the community, locally, nationally and internationally.
