- An internationally recognized teaching qualification for senior secondary schools; alternatively, sometimes the Authorities will recognize a Master's degree in the subject to be taught. For German applicants, the Authorities generally require a 2. Staatsexamen;
- A recognized academic degree in the academic subject;
- Commitment to UWC mission and values;
- A demonstrated passion for teaching and learning in a multicultural context;
- The ability and willingness to teach more than one subject and active participation in our CAS program;
- Willingness to engage students beyond the classroom;
- Adventurous, challenge-seeking spirit;
- International mindedness – international experience is considered an asset;
- Experience in a UWC or IB school is considered an asset but is not a prerequisite.

All applicants should have passion for teaching the subject to highly motivated 16-19-year-old students. In addition, faculty and students at UWC Robert Bosch College see education extending far beyond the classroom. All teachers are expected to lead by example and partner with students in their engagement with the community, locally, nationally and internationally.
