Dear Parents and Guardians,

We have a student who has tested positive for Covid, using school "rapid" Antigen tests. The student has been isolated in the Isolation/Quarantine House until they get a PCR test tomorrow, and then receive the test results. They do not have concerning symptoms at this stage. The student's Parents and NC have been informed.

We have informed their roommates and another student in closer contact with them, and these students will test daily for the next five days.

Fortunately, almost all within this RBC campus community are vaccinated and boosted. Current regulations suggest that no-one else is required to go into isolation/quarantine. We will monitor students' health with ongoing care and students may test daily if they have any concern over their Covid-19 status. Currently, all students and members of staff test at least twice a week when classes are underway - even though this is no longer required in schools by the Authorities.

Naturally, I will keep you informed of any further major developments.
