Dear Parents and Guardians,

Several Parents and Guardians were required to pay €300 as 'Caution Money', as part of the financial agreement (calculated family by family according to financial ability) for your Children, our students, to attend RBC.

RBC has decided not to deduct any amounts from Caution Money that was paid. This is not because there were no damages, but because we think there was no malicious damage.

If you paid Caution Money and would like it to be refunded to your Bank Account, please will you confirm this with RBC Accountant Frau Viola Ali (viola.ali@uwcrobertboschcollege.de). If you wish your Child to be refunded the Caution Money directly, also please will you confirm this with Frau Ali (viola.ali@uwcrobertboschcollege.de) as soon as possible, so that she can draw the funds to do so on Friday 19th May.

However, if you are willing and able, it would be wonderful if you would consider donating (part of) the Caution Money to RBC. The reality is that every year, parents', guardians', National Committees' and UWC international donors' generous and often sacrificial financial contributions still amount to less than 20% of the running costs of RBC. This leaves RBC needing to find funders for over 80% of the running costs to maintain our approach of fully meeting the financial need of each and every student who is nominated to attend RBC.
