## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### Where can I buy my Reunion ticket?

You can purchase your ticket — including accommodation and meals — right here: <https://tickets.uwcrobertboschcollege.de/reunion2026/>. We can't wait to welcome you back!

### When is the registration deadline?

Please register by May 1. And if you're hoping to secure on-campus accommodation, remember that beds are limited — early registration is your best bet!

### Do I need a ticket even if I'm not staying on campus or eating in the mensa?

Yes, please do register and grab your free ticket even if you're just joining us for a day or two. This helps us ensure everyone on campus is accounted for and keeps things safe for all.

### What is the programme for the Reunion?

### How do I get to the RBC campus?

We're excited to help you find your way back!

- By car: Parking is limited, so please use one of the 10 available spaces at the UWC RBC car park next to the newly built bike shed, opposite the flower field.
- From Freiburg train station: Take Tram 1 towards Littenweiler and exit at Emil-Gött-Straße — it's then about a 10-minute walk to campus. Taxis are also available (e.g. Taxi Freiburg: +49 761 555 555).
- From Frankfurt Airport: Check train connections at [www.bahn.de](http://www.bahn.de)
- From Basel Airport: Check bus options at [www.freiburger-reisedienst.de](http://www.freiburger-reisedienst.de) and train options at [www.bahn.de](http://www.bahn.de)

### Can we stay in the student houses on campus?

Yes — just like old times! Student houses will be open from Friday afternoon (15:00) until Sunday afternoon (15:00). A few things to know before you book:

- Around 45 beds are available on a first-come, first-served basis — so book early!
- Rooms and bathrooms are shared, and there is no air conditioning.
- Bed linen is provided — please bring your own towels and toiletries.
- You'll receive a keycard on arrival (a deposit is required).
- Rooms remain unlocked, so please leave valuables at home.
- No smoking or alcohol in the student houses.
- Please be mindful of neighbours and campus residents — quiet hours begin at 22:00.

Prefer to stay nearby? There are also lovely accommodation options in Freiburg to explore. For example: HOKK Hotel im Sportpark, Jugendherberge Freiburg, Black Forest Hostel, Gasthaus Schiff, etc.

## Are partners and children welcome at the Reunion?

Absolutely — the more the merrier! Partners and children are warmly welcome to join you. A few things to keep in mind for families:

- There is no dedicated children's programme and no babysitting services available during the Reunion, so please plan accordingly.
- If you'd like to stay in the student houses on campus, you're welcome to — we'll do our best to accommodate your room allocation needs, but please note we cannot guarantee specific room arrangements, particularly for later registrations.

## Do we need to eat meals in the mensa?

Not at all — you're welcome to eat off campus if you prefer. That said, if you're spending the day at campus events, eating on-site can be really convenient. Please note there are no cooking facilities available on campus.

## Who else is coming? Can I see the attendee list?

We encourage everyone who has registered and completed payment to add their name to the attendee list [link]. We will update the list weekly. It's a lovely way to see familiar faces before you even arrive!

## What should I wear?

There's no dress code — come as you are! But if you happen to still own an RBC hoodie or T-shirt tucked away somewhere, now is absolutely the time to bring it out. If you don't have any RBC merch, no worries at all — you'll be able to order a Reunion t-shirt in advance or pick up RBC merchandise on campus. It might be useful to bring some sports clothes and clothes that could get dirty for some of the CAS and college job activities. If you fancy dressing up a little, the festive dinner on Saturday evening is the perfect occasion for it.

## Will there be medical or nurse services available on campus?

The College will not be providing medical services during the Reunion weekend. If you have specific medical needs or concerns, please make sure you come prepared and know how to access local healthcare services if needed.

## What if I need a visa invitation letter?
